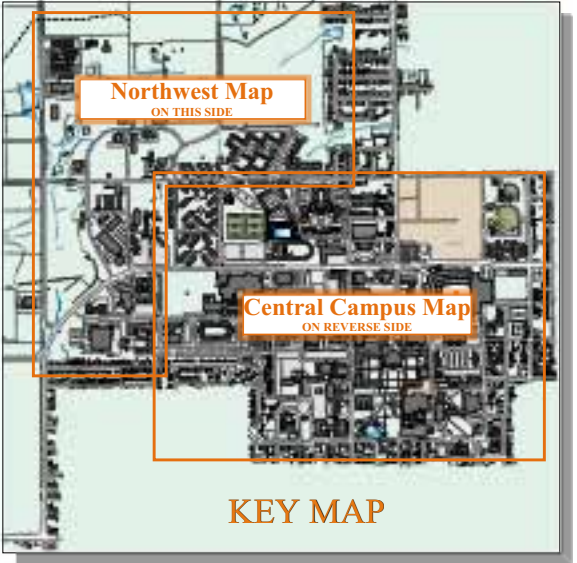


**LEGEND**

**ACCESS NOTES:**

**A. Student Union:** Most student services, such as Admissions, Financial Aid, Registrar, Bursar, and Student Disability Services & ADA Compliance are located here. Accessible seating for the theatre is located on the 3rd floor. Please contact the Central Information Desk (room 242, 744-5234) for further information on access and/or to facilitate any accommodation needs. The Atherton Hotel is in the south wing of the Student Union. For accommodations or reservations, call 744-6835 V/TTY or go to the hotel lobby. Six (6) accessible parking spaces are located in the Student Union Parking Garage on the lower level, near the accessible entrance to the basement. An additional six (6) spaces are located on the top level at the north end of the lot, facing the hotel. Raised vans must park in the upper level area due to low clearance into the lower levels.

**B. Athletic Village:** Several Athletic projects are under construction in this area.

**C. Athletic Facilities:** Additional accessible parking spaces are provided with shuttle service for sporting events in Boone Pickens Stadium and Gallagher-Iba Arena (within the Athletic Center). Individuals with disabilities must make arrangements to purchase event tickets through the Athletic Ticket Office and notify staff of any accommodation needs at the earliest possible date. For non-athletic events, please contact the program sponsors in advance of events.

**D. Colvin Recreation Center:** This facility is the main recreation center for students. It is supported through student activity fees and paid memberships from OSU faculty, staff, and alumni. Through the OSU Adaptive Sports Program, all areas of the facility and programs are accessible, either via integrated activities or by participating in sponsored adaptive sports and recreation programs. One example of a sponsored program is the OSU Wheelchair Basketball Team. **CAMPUS ACCESS GUIDE**  
For Individuals With Disabilities

**INTRODUCTION**  
This is the 5th edition of the OSU Stillwater Access Guide. It has been updated to depict current, key access features. It contains one large map of central campus (printed on the reverse side) along with NW campus, Legend, and a smaller Key Map (smaller map combining central & NW campus).

Dedicated efforts of staff, students, and the Physical Plant, Office of Facilities Information have made the maps as accurate and helpful as possible. The campus is ever changing, however, and your assistance is needed to continually update and publish the best possible product. **Please notify the Office of ADA Compliance (315 Student Union, 744-7116 V/TTY) to report errors or make suggestions.**

All sidewalks should be considered accessible routes, unless highlighted in red. Accessibility features are depicted in blue, yellow, orange, and red, with red signifying barriers. Please refer to the LEGEND for definitions of symbols used to identify curb openings, ramps, accessible entries and power-assisted doors, accessible parking spaces, accessible restroom locations, and other access features.

**PARKING INFORMATION**  
Parking in all lots is by permit only (obtained through OSU Parking Services, 110 Multimodal Transportation Terminal at Hall of Fame Ave. and Monroe St.). Visitors should obtain a free OSU Visitors Permit and display their State Accessibility Permit when parking in marked accessible spaces. Paid parking is available in the Student Union Garage and the Monroe Street Garage. A few metered parking areas also exist. OSU faculty, staff, and students must purchase an OSU permit with accessibility parking status. This permit allows you to park in any faculty, staff, student, or accessible space. Parking without an appropriate permit will result in tickets, fines, and/or towing at the owner's expense.
